## KUCIIONS

- Choose one of the photos to paint.
- $\bullet$  Do 2 3 quick sketches in your sketch pad to familiarize yourself with the frame, big shapes, and some shading details.
- Use a sheet of watercolor paper & cut it to the size of this paper so it will fit into your binder or notebook.
- Draw guide lines for your big shapes

- Draw more shapes for the shadows & highlights.
- Paint the black areas first. Then make deep shadow colors.
- For each major color you mix, make note of how you made it by painting a box above, and writing the pigments used in the mix.
- Keep mixing and painting, working in the Sunrise method of darks first, and getting lighter and lighter until you finish with highlights.
