ROOMPREP: Cut larger watercolor

paper in half to get smaller sheets for the first paintings in STEP 2 and 3. Get blank paper sacks or purchase brown kraft paper for the bark paintings in STEP 5 and 6. You might want to tear the "bark" ahead of time to save time.

Purchase rolls of brown kraft paper at the paint section of big hardware stores. They sell it for drop cloths.

Print all of your PDFs from the lesson plan and cut any references apart as needed.
