



Lesson Preparation - KidsART

Lizards & Desert - Week 36b

ROOM PREP: Cut larger watercolor paper in half to get smaller sheets for the first paintings in STEP 2 and 3. Get blank paper sacks or purchase brown kraft paper for the bark paintings in STEP 5 and 6. You might want to tear the “bark” ahead of time to save time.

Purchase rolls of brown kraft paper at the paint section of big hardware stores. They sell it for drop cloths.

Print all of your PDFs from the lesson plan and cut any references apart as needed.

1. **Warmup** (20 minutes)- Artists’ Choice
2. **Draw 2 Parts** (10 min) - Draw outlines for the desert
3. **Oil Pastel** (15) -Add sky and texture with oil pastels

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Break - end of part one if dividing into 2 sessions

4. **Watercolor** (15) - Make resist paintings. Display lizard slideshow.
5. **Lizard Bark** (5) - Students make “bark” out of brown Kraft paper.
6. **Lizard Drawings** (5) - Draw lizard outline
7. **Zen Doodles** (15) - Make doodle designs inside the lizard shape
8. **Clean Up** (5) - Everyone helps
