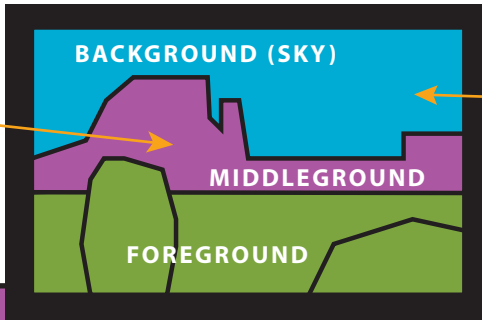




Drawing the 3 Big Parts of a Desert Scene **Lizards & Desert**

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Draw the
middleground
first. Here are
two references
to choose from.
#1 looks farther
away than #2



Once you've drawn the
 Middleground, the Sky
is done too! It's just an
air shape above the
 Middleground.
Add some clouds like
these if you want.



OR



Add a moon if you
want to
make a
night-time
scene.



Then draw some fun things in the foreground like
rocks, bushes, and maybe a cactus, such as these.



Teacher: Read the instructions to your students. Have them look at the small picture with the black frame first. Then point out how each of the 3 big parts has a color. Inside the color boxes for each part are pictures that they can draw from to make a desert scene. Begin with the Middleground, because that also creates the background sky.
