1. **Brainstorm** (20 minutes)- Students create 3 or 4 great designs.
2. **Prep** (10 min) - Plastic tape covers or is removed from boxes
3. **Assembly** (40) - Construct the sculpture.
4. **Primer** (10) - cover sculpture with gesso or white paint.
5. **Cleanup** (5) - Superwash brushes and tidy.
6. **Colorstorm** (10) - Use oil pastels to brainstorm color ideas.
7. **Clean up** (3) - Clean up all the bits of trash and write names.
